



ZOOREACH SCHOLARSHIPS 2016-17 GUIDELINES AND OPPORTUNITIES

ZooReach Scholarships are available for Arizona Department of Education designated Title I schools grades K – 12 that have 50 percent or more of their enrollment on a free or reduced lunch program. Scholarships are offered for field trip visits to the Phoenix Zoo *and* for education programs that take place at the Zoo or in the classroom.

Field Trip Scholarships

Qualifying school groups are welcome to enjoy a day at the Zoo anytime for a reduced rate. These scholarships are unlimited and even cover multiple visits from the same school.

Admission to the Zoo – Come visit and learn!

- Scholarship provides admission to the Zoo at a rate of \$2/person, including chaperones, teachers and/or parents, for a minimum group size of at least 15.
- To take advantage of this scholarship, download a Field Trip General Admission Form from phoenixzoo.org and complete and submit the form per the instructions.

Education Program Scholarships

Qualifying schools are eligible to receive one program per year from each of the following three areas. Education program scholarships are offered until funds are exhausted. Scholarships become available on September 6, 2016. Call 602.914.4333 for reservations.

Field Trip Programs – Make your field trip unforgettable!

Choose one of the following:

Guided Tour

- A one-hour program for groups up to 35 people.
- Program engages students in an inquiry-based walking tour of select Zoo trails.
- Estimated Value of scholarship: \$70*

Animal Discovery

- A 45-minute program for a group of up to 75 people.
- Program includes live animal ambassadors presented by engaging and knowledgeable instructors.
- Estimated Value of scholarship: \$75*

Wild Workshop

- A one-hour workshop for a group of up to 35 people.
- Workshop includes hands-on, inquiry-based activities to encourage students to explore a variety of scientific concepts. Some workshops may be visited by a live animal ambassador.
- Estimated Value of scholarship: \$125*

Programs in the Classroom – Let us bring the Zoo to you!

Choose one of the following:

ZooToYou: Live On Location!

- A one-hour program at your school for a group of up to 75 people.
- Program includes live animal ambassadors presented by engaging and knowledgeable instructors.
- Live on Location scholarship programs can be booked on Mondays or Tuesdays throughout the year.
- Estimated Value of scholarship: \$190*
- Note: If your school is located outside the Phoenix metropolitan area, call the ZooMobile office at 602.914.4329 to see if the Zoo is coming to your area this year. ZooMobile programs are free to qualifying schools.

ZooToYou: Distance Learning

- A 45 – 60 minute program broadcast into your classroom for a group of up to 40 people (single classroom). All you need is a computer, a projector and an Internet connection and you'll have access to dynamic programming from the Zoo.
- Program includes live animal ambassadors presented by engaging and knowledgeable instructors.
- Distance Learning scholarship programs can be booked on Wednesday or Thursday mornings throughout the school year.
- Estimated Value of scholarship: \$90*

Night Camp – An unforgettable overnight experience!

- Camp includes dinner, live animal presentations, activities, hikes on Zoo grounds, continental breakfast and Zoo admission for the following day.
- Scholarship provides funds for 36 children and four adults to attend (minimum of 25 required) and includes a pizza dinner.
- Scholarship also includes up to 36 t-shirts for the students attending the camp. Adult t-shirts are **not** included, but can be purchased.
- ZooReach Night Camp scholarships can be scheduled for any available night from September 28 until March 1.
- Estimated value of scholarship: \$2,324.00*

- ❖ Additional programs (Field Trip or ZooToYou) or participants (Night Camp) can be scheduled to supplement scholarship value. Some discounts may apply. Please call 602.914.4333 for details about additional program or participant costs.
